G.S.R. ____ In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Archaeological Survey of India (Class III – Non-Gazetted Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1968, in so far it relates to the posts of Conservation Assistant Grade II, Foreman (Works) and Caretaker, except as respect things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Junior Conservation Assistant and Conservation Assistant in the Archeological Survey of India, Ministry of Culture, namely :---

1. Short title and commencement. --- (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Culture, Archeological Survey of India, Junior Conservation Assistant and Conservation Assistant (Group 'C' posts), Recruitment Rules, 2016.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Application. --- These rules shall apply to post specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Number of posts, classification and pay band and grade pay /scale of pay. --- The number of the said posts, their classification and the Pay Band and Grade Pay/ scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule annexed to these rules.

4. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualification etc. ---The method of recruitment to the posts, age limit, qualification and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in column (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.

5. Disqualification. ---- No person

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

Shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such and other party to the marriage and there are other ground for doing so, exempting person from the operation to this rule.

6. Power to relax. --- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons in consultation with UPSC.

7. Saving. ---- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
