**Subject: Amendment in the R/rules of the post(s) of Surveyor Grade I and Surveyor Grade II**

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The Principal Recruitment rules of the posts of Surveyor Grade I and II in the Archaeological Survey of India were notified in 1968. It is proposed to amend these rules to update the provisions in accordance with the guidelines of the Department of Personnel & Training.

While the mode of recruitment and qualifications required for both the above posts are proposed to be retained, changes have been made with regard to the existing sanctioned strength, pay scale and age limit. The age limit has been increased by two years (27 years) in respect of the post of Surveyor Gr.II. In the case of surveyor Gr.I, being a group 'B' post, the age limit for direct recruits has been raised to 30 years.

The pay scale of the post of Surveyor Gr.I was upgraded from the pre-revised pay scale of Rs.4500-7000 (Group C) to Rs.5000-8000 w.e.f. 1.1.1996. The post is in the Grade Pay of Rs.4200 (pre revised) a Group 'B' post, and presently in Level 6 of paymatrix. In view of the upgradation, the qualifying service required for promotion from a post in GP.2400 (Surveyor Gr.II) to a post in GP:4200 (Surveyor Gr.I) has been revised to 10 years in accordance with the DOPT guidelines .

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The provisions suggested in the draft Recruitment rules circulated herewith are however subject to approval of the authority competent to approve these rules.
