Subject: Representation regarding amendment in the R/rules of the post of Deputy Superintending Horticulturist in the Archaeological Survey of India

With reference to their representations regarding amendment in the recruitment rules of the post of Deputy Superintending Horticulturist, consequent on the reduction of the sanctioned strength to 3, it is informed that Against the sanctioned strength of 3 posts of Deputy Superintending Horticulturist, 3 posts of Assistant Superintending Horticulturist and 1 post of Landscape Architect have been proposed in the feeder grade for promotion. The method of recruitment to the post has therefore, been proposed as 33^{1/3}% by promotion and 66^{2/3}% by Direct Recruitment. The post of DSH is a Group A post. The post of Senior Horticulture Assistant (Level-6) can be considered for promotion to the higher post of Assistant Superintending Horticulturist (Level-7) only and not to the post of Deputy Superintending Horticulturist which will otherwise amount to double channel of promotion. The provisions that are proposed in the revised rules circulated through website vide letter of even number dated 15th October, 2018 are in accordance with the instructions of the Department of Personnel & Training.
