The existing Recruitment rules of the post of **Director Epigraphy (Arabic & Persian)** in the Archaeological Survey of India, notified in 2007 are proposed to be amended and notified afresh. The existing provisions on mode of recruitment shall remain as Composite Method (Deputation (ISTC) plus promotion) for the reason that there is no change in the sanctioned strength of the feeder post which has remained as 1 (one). Other changes that have been made are mostly related to change in the pay scale as per CCS (RP) Rules, 2016.

The draft Recruitment rules of the above post is hereby circulated among all the stakeholders for their information in pursuance of the Department of Personnel and Training O.M. No. AB-14017/61/2008-Estt.(RR) dated 13.10.2015.

The provisions proposed in the draft rules are in accordance with the model Recruitment rules of the post circulated by the Department of Personnel & Training and subject to approval of the DOPT/UPSC.

If any of the stakeholders wish to represent on any of the provisions incorporated in the Recruitment Rules, they may do so within 30 days of this communication appearing on the ASI website. Notification

G.S.R.— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Archaeological Survey of India, Directors Epigraphy (Sanskrit and Dravidian, and Arabic and Persian Inscriptions); Superintending Epigraphists and Deputy Superintending Epigraphists (Sanskrit, Dravidian, and Arabic and Persian Inscriptions) Group 'A' posts, Recruitment rules, 2006, in so far as it relates to the post of Director Epigraphy (Arabic and Persian inscriptions), except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Director Epigraphy (Arabic and Persian Inscriptions) in the Archeological Survey of India, Ministry of Culture, namely :-

1. Short title and commencement.— (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Culture, Archeological Survey of India, Director Epigraphy (Arabic and Persian Inscriptions (Group 'A' post), Recruitment Rules, 2019.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of post, classification and level in the pay matrix. — The number of post, its classification and the level in the pay matrix attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualification etc. —The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualification and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in column (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification. — No person,-

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds, for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax. — Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation

with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving. — Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

The departmental Superintending Epigraphist (Arabic and Persian inscriptions) in Level-11 in the pay matrix with 5 years regular service in the grade will also be considered along with outsiders and in case he/she is selected for appointment to the post, the same shall be deemed to have been filled by promotion.</p> <p>Note 1.— The period of deputation (including short term contract) including period of deputation (including short term contract) in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation or department of the Central Government shall not exceed four years. The maximum age-limit for appointment by deputation shall be 'not exceeding fifty six years' as on the last date of receipt of applications.</p> <p>Note 2.—The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, the deputationist shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.</p>
