G.S.R. (E).- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Ministry of Culture, Archaeological Survey of India, Conservation Cadre (Group 'A' and Group 'B' Gazetted posts), Recruitment Rules, 2019 in so far as they relate to the post of **Deputy Superintending Archaeological Engineer** except as respect things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Deputy Superintending Archaeological Engineer in the Archaeological Survey of India, Ministry of Culture, namely:-

1. **Short title and Commencement.**- (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Culture, Archaeological Survey of India, Deputy Superintending Archaeological Engineer (Group 'A' posts), Recruitment Rules, 2023.
2. They shall come into force on the date of their publications in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification and Level in the Pay Matrix.- The number of the said posts, their classification and Level in the Pay Matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualification etc.- The method of recruitment to the posts, age-limit, qualification and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in column (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.

4. Disqualification.- No person

(a) who, has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) who, having a spouse living a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other ground for doing so, exempt any person from the operation to this rule.

5. Power to relax.- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons in consultation with Union Public Service Commission.

6. Saving.- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Schedule Tribes, Other Backward Classes, ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the order issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

posts on regular basis in the parent cadre or department; or
(ii) with five years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on regular basis in posts in Level-7 in the pay matrix or equivalent in the parent cadre or department; and
(b) possessing the educational qualification and experience as prescribed for direct recruits under column (7).

Note 1: The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, the deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

Note 2: The period of deputation including the period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some organisation or department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be 'not exceeding 56 years' as on the last date of receipt of applications.
