Qualification	Master's Degree in Ancient or Medieval Indian History/Archaeology/Anthropology/Geology (with knowledge of Pleistocene age)/ Pali, Prakrit, Arabic or Persian and Indian Classical Languages such as Tamil, Sanskrit, Telugu, Kannada, Malayalam & Odia from a recognized University or equivalent with minimum aggregate of 55% marks (50% in respect of candidates belonging to reserve categories as per Govt. rules)	
	Sponsored candidates nominated through Ministry of External Affairs, from SAARC and BIMSTEC Countries are working in the field of Archaeology or Museology or Conservation or Culture.	
Age	The upper age limit as on 10.09.2023 should not exceed 25 years, which is relaxable to the candidates belonging to reserve categories and departmental (Central/State Govt. / University) officials as per Govt. rules.

Sponsorships Quota	The Sponsorships Quota is as under: State Archaeology Department/ University. Selection Procedure	The selection procedure will comprise of written test followed by personal interview of shortlisted candidates.	
Written Test & Personal Interview	Without submission of final year mark sheet candidate is not eligible to appear for the written test. Written entrance examination is scheduled to be held on 20 September, 2023 and personal interview of shortlisted candidates will be held on 29 th & 30 th September 2023	
Stipend	During the entire period of two years course the students (excluding sponsored candidates) would be entitled to a stipend of Rs. 8000/- per month, in addition to second class railway or ordinary bus fares as travelling allowances to attending outstations training camps.	
How to Apply	Interested candidate fulfilling the eligibility criteria should apply online through ASI website i.e. www.asi.nic.in from 20/08/2023 to 10/09/2023 and no other mode of application will be acceptable.	
Last Date of Submission	Submit your duly filled application only by online mode latest by 10 th September, 2023. In future any further corrigendum/addendum will only be uploaded on ASI website www.asi.nic.in . Hence all applicants are required to check the ASI website regularly.
